It is amazing but this time last year I was setting up an Exhibition Stand at The Gathering (a large festival run by Christian Vision for Men), its amazing what a difference a year can make to our lives. I was due to be going again this weekend thankfully they are doing it all online and will be featuring a video about what we do.

We are still very actively engaged in our outreach work and seeing around 30-35 clients per day. It is amazing to continue to being able to have conversations with the clients as people start to open up and their hopes and needs as well as being open to receiving prayer.

A change in the the way that we continue to work will be that Project Beacon will no longer be called this as the Trustees have decided to fully amalgamate it into the rest of the Outreach work that we are doing on Mon-Fri. We will then have two teams going out from Monday to Saturday every morning/lunchtime.

I hope that by the time the next newsletter comes out, I will be able to confirm some really exciting plans that we have for GCM as the lease comes up in November on our current centre and we move in to a time of leaving The George Whitefield Centre after 5 years and carrying on restructuring the way that we help those in need in some new and exciting ways..

Thanks to the volunteers who are doing outreach work for us and also to the staff at Pret a Manger in Cheltenham who have partnered with us to provide us with food for outreach sessions on a weekly basis, this week we collected over 60 meals from them.

We have also continued our partnerships with donations from Tesco, Asda and Fare Share.

We must also thank the Gloucestershire Community Foundation for a follow up grant to the one they gave us at the start of the epidemic.



One of our clients was released from prison last week and on his first day out he came to see us with this card that he had made.



I asked some of our staff and volunteers what has kept their spirits up over these difficult past few months. Here are some of their responses;

*'Having the time to sit down and really talk to my daughter without playing revolving doors or using a phone. Hearing birds sing clearly rather than through the rumble of traffic. Seeing the seasons come to life by having the time to observe flowers growing in the garden. Normally you don't have the time to have a daily inspection. It has been beautiful to see. The fun and humour of zoom meetings !!! Technology is always amusing. Imagine trying to get 25 family members on a face book messenger video call is hilarious. But most of all what has kept our spirits up is that we have all remained safe and well. My husband has 4 brothers and sisters And I have a brother. All with children and grandchildren. Not one of us has been ill - that is the greatest gift of all - our health, oh and Gin.'*

*'Being part of the Feed the 5000 team. Zoom meetings with family and friends. Seeing funding coming in for GCM some unexpected, lots from our faithful regular supporters.'*

*'For me its going back and doing what we do best which is looking after these guys the best way we can, and knowing that i can come home feeling very humble.'*

*'The beautiful weather we have had and being able to spend time in my garden has really kept my spirits up. Plus exploring the local woods finding new walks and just being in God's amazing creation.'*
